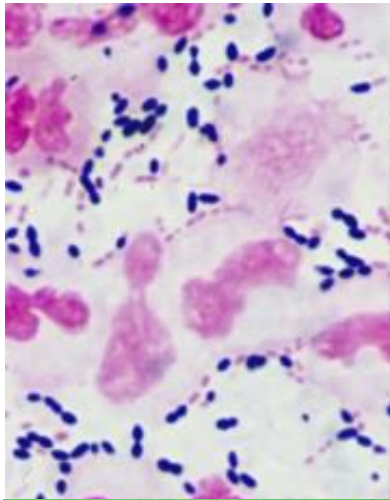


## Postgraduate Diploma in Infectious Diseases (PDipID) 19<sup>th</sup> Intake Certificate in Infectious Diseases (CertID), and Infectious Disease Courses



### Postgraduate Diploma in Infectious Diseases (PDipID)

- Quotable qualification by the Hong Kong Medical Council.
- **Application Deadline for 19<sup>th</sup> intake: 31 August 2017**
- Mode of attendance: part-time (2 years).

#### Entrance Requirements

- Medically qualified + one year's postgraduate clinical experience.

#### Method of Instruction

- Lectures: six two-day weekends (April, July, and November for 2 academic years).
- Part-time clinical attachment: infectious disease consultations, discussions, tutorials, and presentations.
- Infectious disease project
- Literature review.

### Certificate in Infectious Diseases (CertID)

- CME/CNE awarded.
- Call for applications: rolling basis, April, July, or November each year.
- Mode of attendance: part-time (2 years).

#### Entrance Requirements

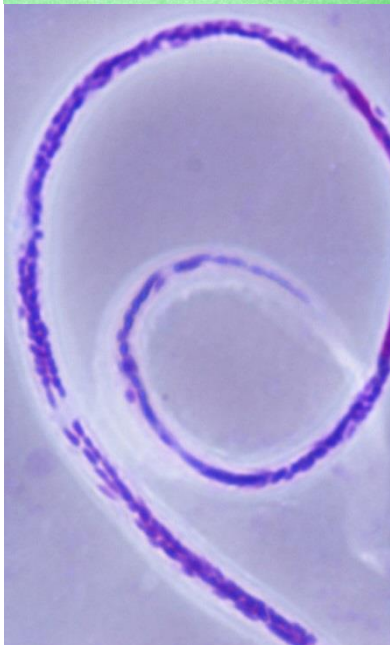
- All medical or nursing graduates, healthcare/science workers, pharmacists, laboratory technicians, medical doctors, and healthcare workers of the HKU-Shenzhen Hospital.

#### Method of Instruction

- Six two-day weekend courses.
- There will be a quiz after completion of each course.
- Performance of these quizzes will constitute the basis for assessment.
- Medium of instruction: English.

COURSE 5 (April 2018) – Tropical diseases in the developed world

COURSE 6 (July 2018) – Infections in immunocompromised hosts and common infective problems in general practice

COURSE 1 (November 2018): Infectious diseases update and emerging infections.

COURSE 2 (April 2019): Infectious disease emergencies, indwelling device and surgical infections.

COURSE 3 (July 2019): Common problems in infectious disease.
