Infectious Disease Courses

The number of emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases has been rapidly increasing in the past decades. Clinical problems arising from this trend have come down to the level of every clinical specialty. Many such problems arise as complications of the patients' underlying medical or surgical illnesses and their treatment. The management of infectious diseases is now more than merely prescribing antibiotics; other modalities of management including active and passive immunization, the use of immunomodulators, and infection control measures, are of increasing importance.

Objectives of the programmes

The Diploma, Certificate and individual 2-day update courses aim to provide understanding of, and practical experience in, infectious diseases management for physicians, surgeons, clinical microbiologists, clinicians, nurses and other health care workers who are actively involved in the daily management of patients suffering from infectious diseases. Special emphasis is put on infections that are major health problems locally or globally. Those who do not intend or do not meet the entrance requirement of Diploma may consider taking the Certificate programme or individual two-day courses.

Postgraduate Diploma in Infectious Diseases (PDipID)

Since 1998, the Postgraduate Diploma in Infectious Diseases has provided a structured and comprehensive training programme to practicing doctors related to clinical problems in infectious diseases. The course aims to foster postgraduate training in the field of infectious diseases and clinical microbiology, and provides an in-depth coverage on the latest international advances with a unique perspective on their relevance to local practice.

- Call for Applications: November 2016 Intake
- Closing date for application: August 31, 2016
- Mode of Attendance: PT (2 years)

Entrance Requirements

Candidates must be medically qualified with at least one year's postgraduate clinical experience (e.g. in internal medicine, surgery, orthopaedics, accidents and emergency, clinical microbiology, etc.).

Method of Instruction

- Lectures (60 hours): including six two-day weekend courses of at least 10 hours each. Three courses will be organized each year in April, July and November.
- Part-time clinical attachment (60 hours): including infectious disease consultations / rounds / discussions / tutorials and case presentations at the Queen Mary Hospital.
- Project (120 hours).
- Literature review (120 hours).

English will be the medium of instruction.

Fees

Postgraduate Diploma in Infectious Diseases: HK\$28,000

Certificate in Infectious Diseases (CertID)

CME/CNE points will be awarded

- Call for Applications: Rolling basis, applicants may begin programme in April, July, or November each year
- Closing date for application: No closing date, may apply all year round
- Mode of Attendance: PT (2 years)

Entrance Requirements

All medical or nursing graduates, health care/science workers, pharmacists, laboratory technicians, and those medical doctors and healthcare workers of the HKU-Shenzhen Hospital are eligible for the enrollment of the Certificate in Infectious Diseases. It is a 2-year part-time certificate course which consists of six 2-day courses.

Method of Instruction

The whole Certificate programme consists of six 2-day weekend courses. There will be a quiz after completion of each course. The performance of these quizzes will constitute the basis for assessment. English will be the medium of instruction.

Fees

Certificate of Infectious Diseases: HK\$5,400

Individual course (2-day course)

- Offer in April, July and November each year
- CNE/CME points will be awarded
- Participants may wish to undertake individual course of their interest
- Closing date of application: One day before the scheduled course starts

COURSE 4 (18 – 19 November 2017): Radiology and radionuclide imaging in ID, Genitourinary medicine and HIV problems
COURSE 5 (April 2018) – Tropical diseases in the developed world

COURSE 6 (July 2018) – Infections in immunocompromised hosts and common infective problems in general practice

COURSE 1 (November 2018): Infectious diseases update and emerging infections.

COURSE 2 (April 2019): Infectious disease emergencies, indwelling device and surgical infections.
