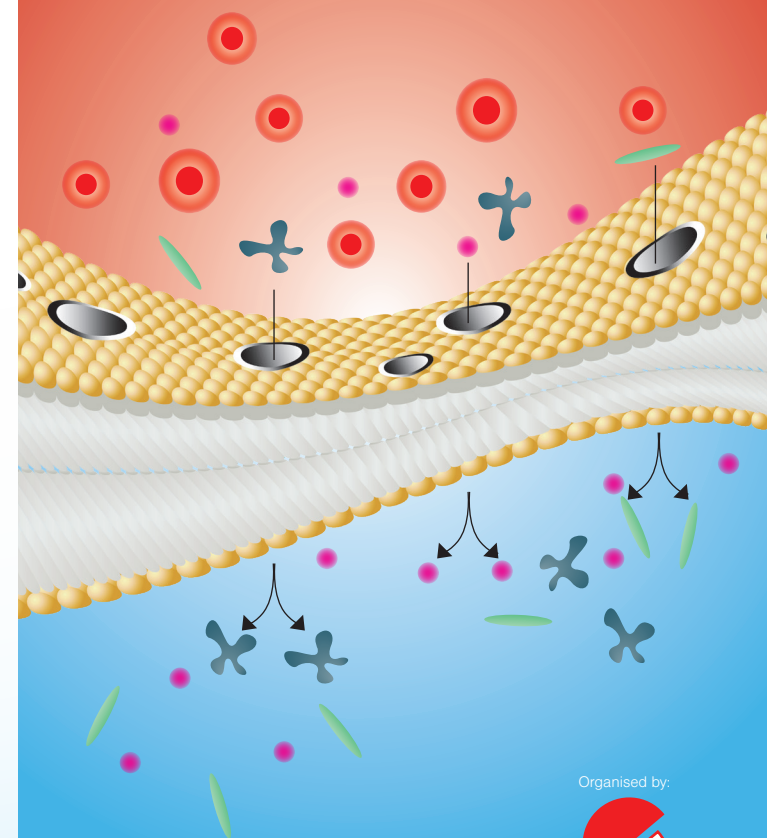

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The 2nd Singapore Society of Nephrology Continuous Renal Replacement Therapy and Extra Corporeal Blood Purification Course 2018 combines Nephrology and Intensive Care expertise in this inaugural regional education endeavour in Critical Care Nephrology. The objective is to empower the clinician and allied healthcare provider with key competency to care for critically ill patients on continuous renal replacement therapy in daily practice.

The content ranges from basic understanding of continuous renal support and anticoagulation, to advanced applications in specific scenarios including sepsis, cardiorenal syndrome and cardiac surgery, burns and trauma, liver failure, end stage renal disease, as well as novel CRRT and extra-corporeal techniques in related conditions.

The course is delivered via series of core lectures and small group practicums, facilitated by our invited overseas speakers, local senior Intensivists and Critical Care Nephrologists.

Our target audience includes clinicians in Critical Care Medicine and Nephrology, and respective fellows in training. The course will also be highly beneficial to residents in Internal Medicine and Anaesthesia, as well as allied health and nurses working in intensive care or managing blood purification therapy.
