



The EMSB course was developed by The Australian and New Zealand Burn Association (ANZBA) in 1996. It has been proven highly successful and the course is now running internationally, including the UK, Netherlands, Finland, Norway, Bangladesh and the South Pacific Islands. We have been running the course in Hong Kong since 2010.

The emphasis of the EMSB course is on a logical and systematic approach to the assessment, resuscitation and transfer of patients with major burns.

A course manual will be sent to candidates in advance with all the information required for the course. The course is held over one day with the sections:

- Lectures
- Skills stations
- Interactive discussion groups
- Burn case simulations

The course is open to all medical, nursing, and allied health practitioners who might provide initial management to patients with severe burns, such as those who work in the field of pre-hospital and emergency medicine, trauma, surgery, intensive care and burn care.

The course concludes with an assessment. On successful completion, the candidate will receive an official EMSB provider certificate from ANZBA.
