



## Infectious Disease Courses and Postgraduate Diploma Programme 2016–2018

The Infectious Disease Courses and Postgraduate Diploma Programme (PDipID) is offered by the Carol Yu Centre for Infection, The University of Hong Kong. It aims to improve and sustain a high standard in the management, control, and prevention of infectious diseases by providing structured training in all aspects of infectious diseases. Special emphasis will be given to clinical management, use of the diagnostic laboratory, as well as the control and prevention of infections in hospitals and the community.

The programme consists of 6 courses given 3 times a year for 2 years. Participants may take any one of the courses individually or enroll into the PDipID study, which includes other course works.

English is the medium of instruction.
